Overview

ThyssenKrupp Steel USA is a member of the global technology group ThyssenKrupp. Based in Calvert, Alabama, the company was created in 2007 to construct and operate a carbon steel processing facility to serve customers in the NAFTA market. The Company will begin operations in spring of 2010, and when fully operational, will have the capacity to produce 4.3 million metric tons of carbon steel coiled product annually.

- The facility will include a river terminal, hot strip mill, cold rolling mill, four hot dip galvanizing lines, wastewater treatment facilities, and rail yard
- The facility will receive its raw material slabs from ThyssenKrupp CSA, a steel making facility currently under construction on Sepetiba Bay in the state of Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. Operations for ThyssenKrupp CSA are expected to begin in summer of 2010
- The facility will employ approximately 1,800 Team Members when fully operational
